What information may we collect and store

We collect and use information compiled by Google Analytics, which does not include information that can be used to identify you. Information collected by Google Analytics includes but is not limited to: device used to access website, geographical location, and whether you are a new or repeating user.

The information that we collect and store from the contact form on our Website includes your name, business name, phone number, electronic mail, when is a good time to reach you and anything that you include in the message portion of the form. This information could be used to identify you.

How may we use your information

Cookies

A cookie is a small file which asks permission to be placed on your computer's hard drive.
